DAILY CAMPING RULES AND REGULATIONS
CRAWLING VALLEY CAMPGROUND

1. Crawling Valley campground is privately owned and operated, please use respect, and obey these rules for everyone's safety and enjoyment
2. Camping is permitted in designated areas only.
3. A maximum of two (2) units per campsite. The second unit must pay the nightly cost of camping. Tents occupied by children under 18 years of age do not count as an additional unit.
4. The maximum stay for individual or group campsites is 14 nights.
5. Please erect tents on the gravel campsite pad, not on the grassed area.
6. Please keep all personal property on your campsite.
7. CVRS is not responsible for loss or damage to personal property.
8. Receptacles are provided, please do not litter.
9. "Quiet Time" is 11:00 p.m. until the next following 7:00 a.m. In consideration of other campers, generators, music, loud television or radio, loud voices, idling vehicles and barking dogs are not allowed during "Quiet Time".
10. The Camper acknowledges and agrees that CVRS may, in CVRS sole discretion, lock the gate at the entrance to the Campground as a method of controlling access to the campground during all or any portion of the Quiet Time period. A one way, exit only gate may be used to exit the campground whenever the entrance gate is locked.
11. Alcohol is not permitted off of the occupied campsite or in any public areas, including the beach and boat launch.
12. All pets are to be kept under control and within the boundaries of the campsite, and on a leash when removed from the campsite at all times. Pets are not allowed on the beach. The pet owner is responsible for clean up after his/her pet.
13. Fires are to be attended and under adult supervision at all times. Fires must be contained within the fire pits provided. Campground staff has the authority to extinguish fires that are not properly supervised or controlled. No fireworks allowed in the campground.
14. Use beach and reservoir at your own risk. No lifeguard is provided.
15. Off-road vehicles are not permitted within campground boundaries.
16. Please keep your vehicles on designated roads and parking areas.
17. Speed limits for vehicles are 30 km per hour on the entrance road and 15 km per hour within the campground.
18. Boats and trailers may be left at the boat launch or may be stored at the campsite, all at the Boat/Trailer Owner's risk. Any boat or trailer at a campsite may be on graveled pad only. Neither boats nor trailers are permitted on the campsite grassed area at any time.
19. Trailered boats are to be launched at the boat launch only.

20. Boater's speed limit within 30 meters from shore is 10 km per hour.
21. Boats are not permitted in the swimming area.
22. Campsite watering is done by CVRS staff. Campers are responsible for removal of all personal property from the grassed areas. CVRS will not be responsible for water damage to the personal property of the camper.
23. Cutting down, damaging or removal of trees or plant life is prohibited.
24. Campers are responsible for the actions of their guests.
25. Campers are responsible for any damage they cause to the campsite, campground facilities or equipment.
26. Please leave your campsite in the condition in which it was received.
27. Any disregard for the rules and your campsite rental may be terminated immediately with no refund. The campsite must be vacated immediately.
